Tonight we went to the Bureau of Meteorology at the East Sale RAAF Base.

Keith miller, resplendid in his RAAF uniform, escorted us to the Met section where we treated to an in depth over view of the woe workings of the Bureau Meteorology.

The head forecaster at the base is Michael Olden, Michael spoke for about 30 minutes or more explaining most of the termonologies that we hear daily over the radio, TV and read in the news papers, in relation to our weather. He explained that navigation students study meteorology during their navigation course.

The Met Office here is connected to the worldwide link of weather stations and they can, at any time, look at the weather conditions in any part of the world.

Michael explained that they giving long term forecasts, up to 12 hours and short term forecast, up to 3 hours, to the RAAF so as to allow them to plan their flying patterns.

Airforce pilots rely heavily on the information that they get from the Met section, as it will determine the amount of fuel that they need to complete the trip.
