Port of Sale Redevelopment

Tonight we listened to Bruce Graham and Lyndon Webb talk to on the ongoing redevelopment project for the Port of Sale.

Bruce Graham is the Director for Strategic Initiative with the Shire of Wellington. Part of his role is to oversee the transformation of the old Port of Sale into a vibrant community, recreational and tourist centre complete with a retail section, motels and unit development all linked through to the wetlands areas around the southern part of Sale.

Bruce and Lyndon emphasised the many advantages to Sale of this development highlighting that there would be approximately 160 jobs available on completion.

The projected is expected to cost around \$30million with \$2.1million being spent to date.

The next stage is anticipated to commence late 2006 with other developments to be completed are the proposed relocation of the Tafe College from West Sale to the area currently occupied by the Sale Netball courts.

At the end of the address both Bruce and Lyndon were able to answer many questions regarding this project. Chairman Alan thanked both Bruce and Lyndon for their address to night and presented Bruce with a momento of his night with us.
