Tonight his talk was on his deployment to the Central Asian Republic of Kyrgystan. This nation was once a part of the Soviet Union. During the Afghani Conflict against the Taliban /Al Queda forces there was a need for a base closer to Afghanistan and Kyrgystan was chosen.

The coalition force was made up of French Spanish Dutch Danish Norwegian Australian a medical unit from Sth Korea. as well as US forces.

Brian went onto highlight the difficulties that arose within such an assembly of culturally different nations not to mention the Kyrgystani people themselves. He also spoke of the terrain that confronted the coalition forces, as the country is a 90% mountain with 50% being above 10,000 feet. Pres. Col thanked Brian for his interesting and informative talk to us tonight and presented him with a memento of his visit.
