Tonight's guest was John Pernu, John is a field worker for an organisation called GROW. Grow is a self-help type organisation that promotes and stimulates self confidence and stability for those who suffer from depression.

John has been with Grow for over 4 years starting at the grass root level.

The member of the various Grow groups meet weekly in groups of 3 to 15 persons and talk through their problems with each other member of the group. These meetings would normally consist of personal testimony of recovery, as well as an emphasis on mutual support and guidance within a Grow program.

Grow itself was founded in 1957 and currently 370 groups operating in Australia with approximately 200 overseas in the US and Ireland. Funding in Victoria is by the department of Human Services with Grow maintaining their operating and functional independence.

President Col thanked John for his address tonight and presented John with a small memento of his visit here with us tonight.
